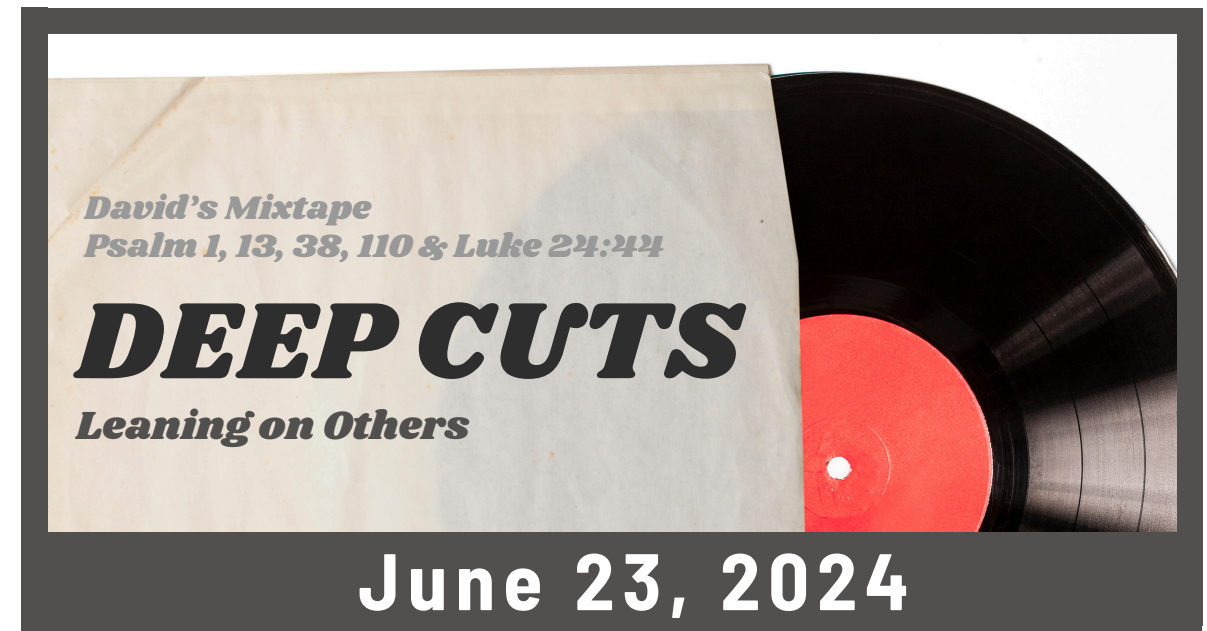
Going to Camp! Lennon Bonestroo is going to Inspiration Hill Camp **June 24-28**. We pray that he will experience the love of Jesus at camp!
