

FRC Is Hiring

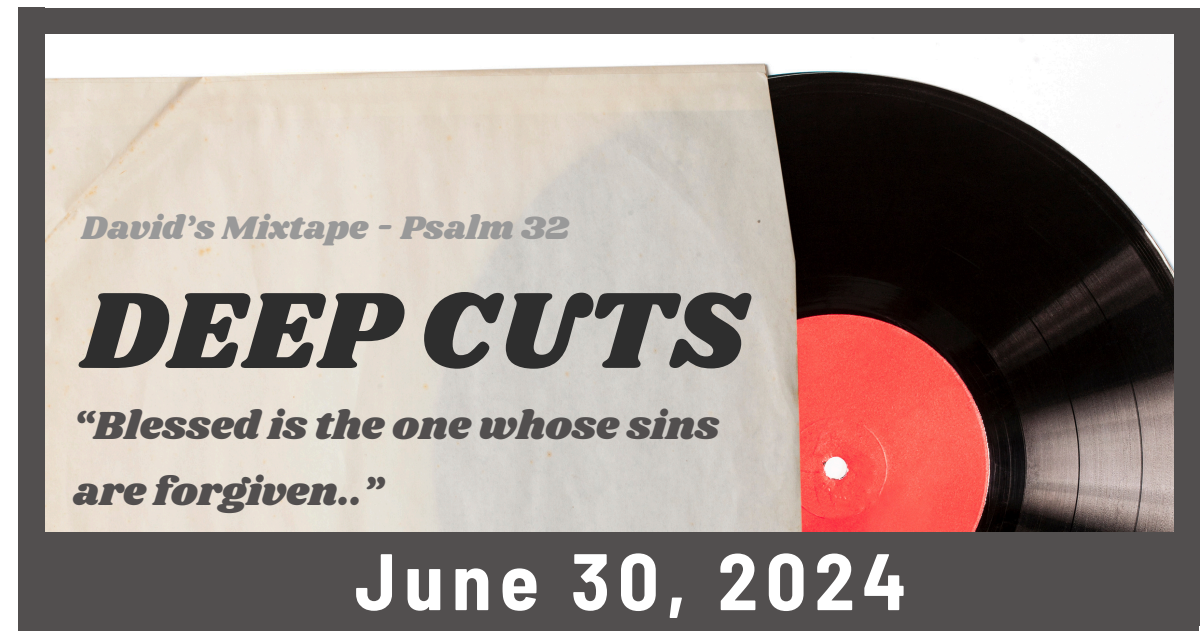
