

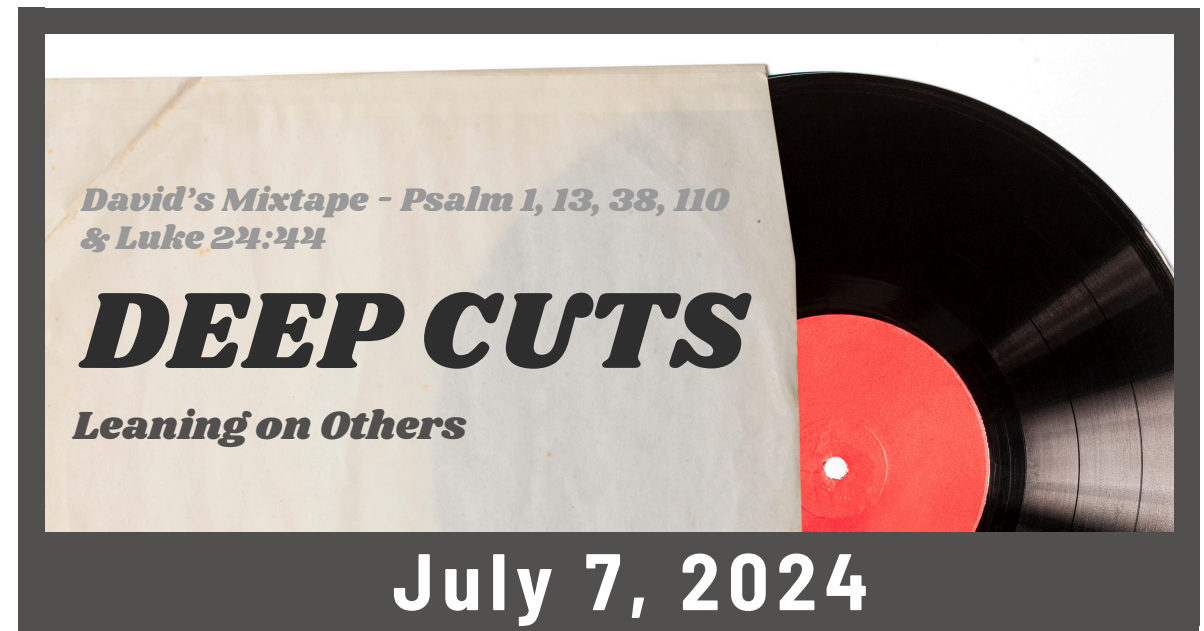
FRC Is Hiring
