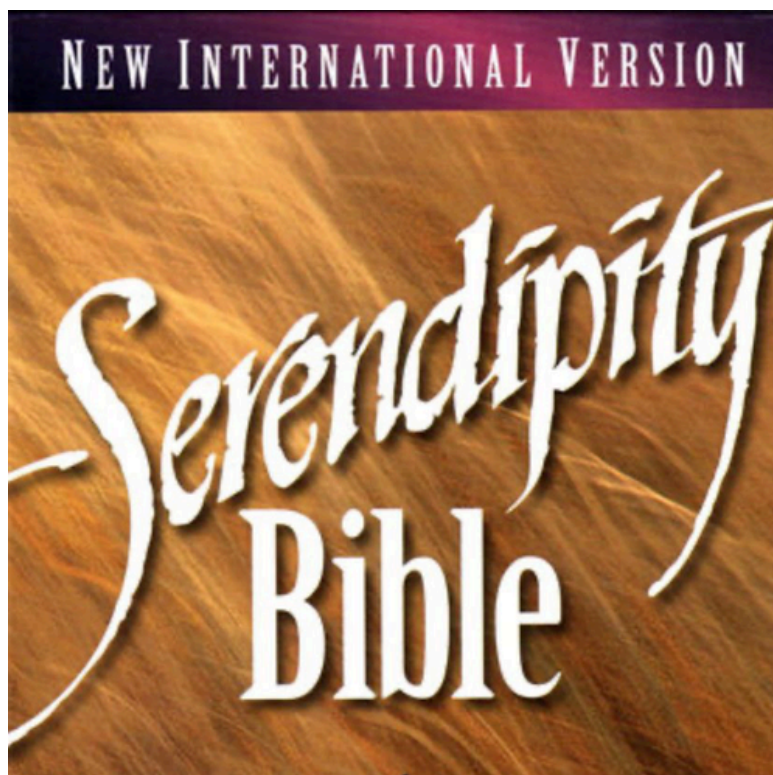


UPCOMING SERMONS

FEATURED BIBLE STUDY: Serendipity



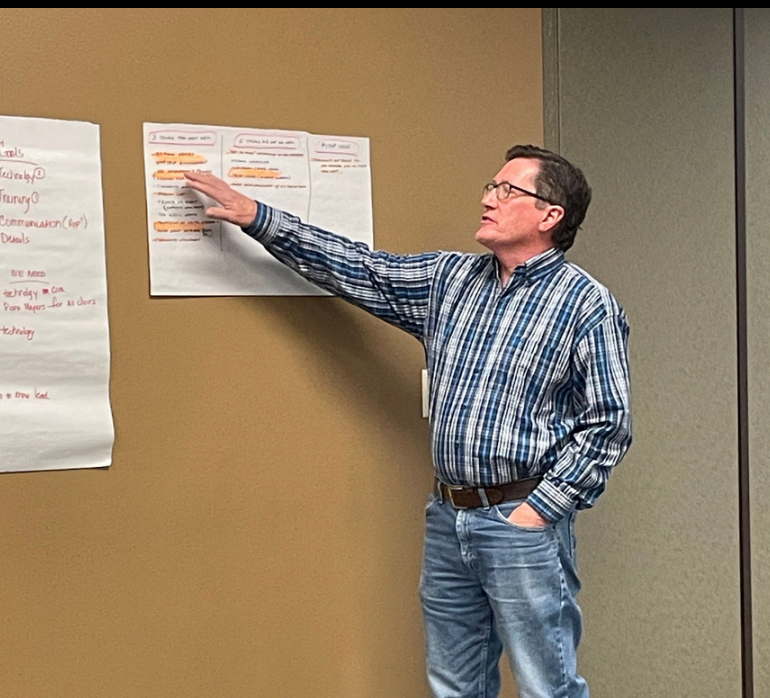
Weekly, Thursday Evenings

The service was a time of preparation for the season of Jesus beginning his journey to the cross, and a reminder that from the dust we have been made, and to dust we shall return.

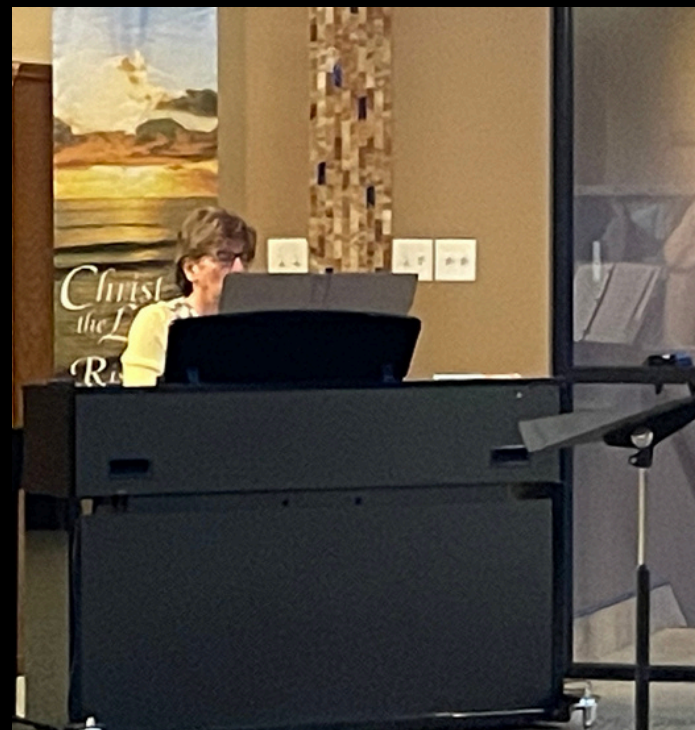
