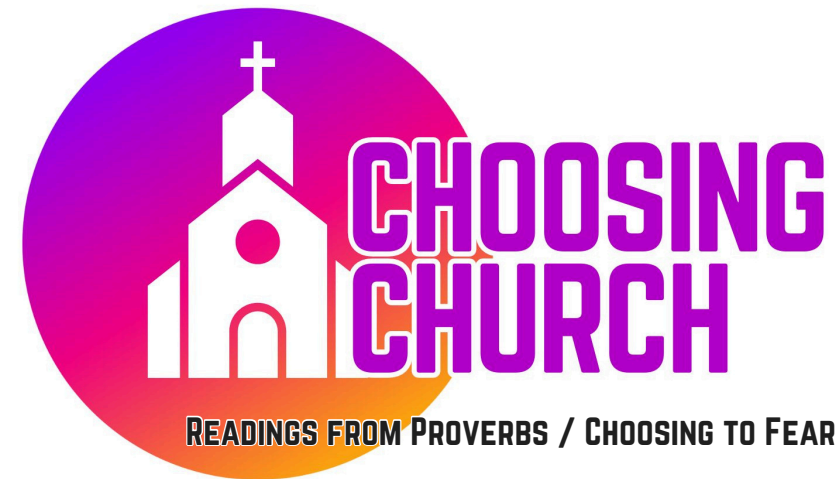

Our mission is to help create a loving environment where the poor and destitute find comfort and solace physically and spiritually with an emphasis on the needs of children. Participants divide their time between building projects and working with children. Kids are welcome on this trip if they are accompanied by an adult. The cost is \$450 per person (includes lodging and food) plus the cost of transportation (driving or flying).
