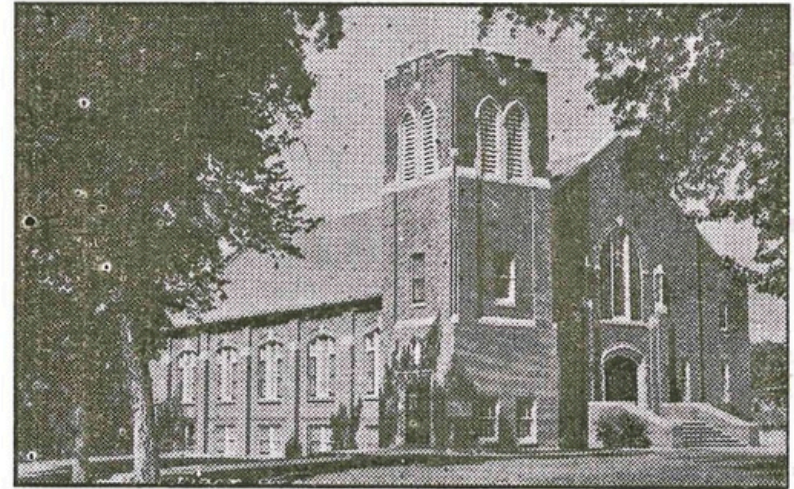

The 10 Commandments - KJV

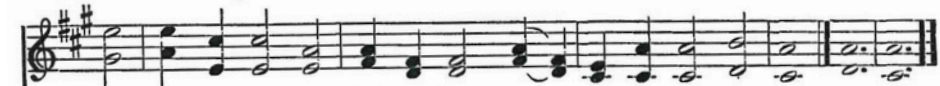

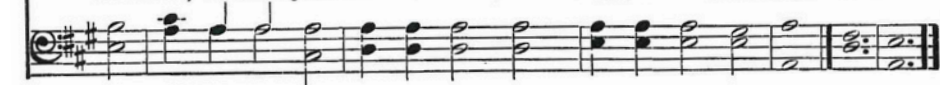

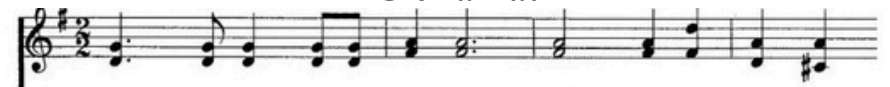
