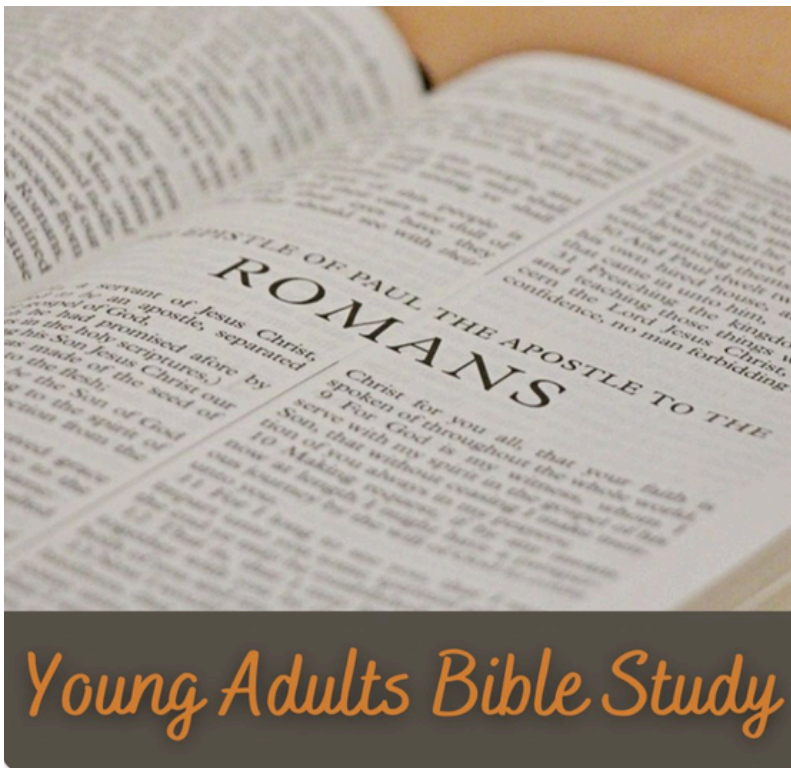
## UPCOMING SERMONS
